

## Second contribution to the knowledge of Dermestidae (Coleoptera) from Réunion

The following species are being recorded from Réunion for the first time: *Anthrenus (Nathrenus) verbasci* (Linnaeus, 1767), *Orphinus (Orphinus) fulvipes* (Guérin-Méneville, 1838).

### INTRODUCTION

The family Dermestidae from Réunion published by Gomy (2000) and Háva (2006). The present second contribution summarized five species collected by French entomologist in the years 1999-2006.

### RESULTS

Subfamily Attageninae  
Tribe Attagenini

*Attagenus (Aethriostoma) madecassus* (Pic, 1916)

**Material examined:** Réunion: Le Port, obtenu par élevage, 29.12.1999, 4 spec., J. Háva det., (3 JPPC, 1 JHAC).

**Distribution.** Species known from Madagascar and Réunion (Háva, 2006).

Subfamily Dermestinae	<i>Orphinus (Orphinus) fulvipes</i> (Guérin-Méneville, 1838)
Tribe Dermestini	

**Dermestes (Dermestinus) maculatus** DeGeer, 1774

**Material examined:** Réunion: Le Tampon, 600 m, sous un cadavre de tangue (*Tenrec echaudatus*, Schreber, 1777), 20.11.1999, 8 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC); Le Tampon, 800 m, dans un composteur, 26.02.2003, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC); Le Tampon, 800 m, sous un cadavre de poulet, 19.11.2000, 2 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC); Le Tampon, 800 m, sous un cadavre de chat, 11.12.2002, 2 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC).

**Distribution.** Cosmopolitan species, from Réunion mentioned by Háva (2006).

Subfamily Megatominae  
Tribe Anthrenini

***Anthrenus (Nathrenus) verbasci* (Linnaeus, 1767)**

**Material examined:** Réunion: Le Tampon, 800 m, intérieur de maison (cuisine), 24.04.2003, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC).

**Distribution.** Cosmopolitan species, new for Réunion.

Tribe Megatomini

***Orphinus (Orphinus) binotatus* Pic, 1937**

**Material examined:** Réunion: Manapany, le kiosque, à la lumière, 27.12.2005, 3 spec., J. Háva det., (2 JPPC, 1 JHAC); Grande-Anse, sous des feuilles de choka (*Aloe vera* var.*barbadensis* Miller) (Liliacés), 17.01.2006, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC); rive de Grand Etang, à la lumière, 26.02.2004, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC); St Joseph, piton Babet, Maison Jean-Jacques, Elevage dans un tronc de palmier, 16.01.2004, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JPPC).

**Distribution.** Species known from Madagascar, Réunion and Tanzania: Zanzibar (Háva, 2006).

**Material examined:** Réunion: Le Tampon, 600 m, au vol, 5.11.2001, 1 female, J. Háva det., (JPPC).

**Distribution.** Cosmopolitan species, new for Réunion.

**KEY TO SPECIES OF DERMESTIDAE  
KNOWN FROM RÉUNION**

(supplemented version of published key by Háva, 2006)

1(4) median ocellus on front absent

2(3) abdomen covered by white and black pubescence; apical part of each elytron with spines; pronotum covered by white pubescence laterally, other part with black (brown) pubescence

.....*Dermestes (Dermestinus) maculatus* DeGeer, 1774

3(2) abdomen covered by unicolorous yellow (or grey) pubescence; apical part of each elytron without spines; pronotum covered by unicolorous pubescence.....

.....*Dermestes (Dermestes) ater* DeGeer 1774

4(1) median ocellus on front present

5(6) elytra covered by scales, antennae 11-segmented .....

.....*Anthrenus (Nathrenus) verbasci* (Linnaeus, 1767)

6(5) elytra covered by pubescence

7(10) prosternum not forming a “collar”, therefore mouthparts free

8(9) each elytron brown to black, with one transverse orange-reddish fascia in anterior half; disc of metasternum nearly twice as long as wide

.....*Attagenus (Attagenus) fasciatus* (Thunberg, 1795)

9(8) each elytron brown, covered by long, yellow pubescence, with more small spots, with white pubescence; disc of metasternum nearly twice as wide as long .....  
...*Attagenus (Aethriostoma) madecassus* Pic, 1916

10(7) prosternum forming a “collar” under which mouthparts fit when head is retracted

11(12) pronotum with strong raised ridge near side margin in basal half; body unicolorous, very small, with very long setation; antennal club with two segments, terminal segment narrow and long .....*Evorinea iota* Arrow, 1915

12(11) pronotum without strong raised ridge near side margin in basal half

13(14) elytra unicolorously brown or light black .....*Orphinus (Orphinus) fulvipes* Guérin-Méneville, 1838

14(13) elytra bicolorous

15(16) each elytron with orange-red fasciae; antennal club 3- segmented, terminal segment very large and flat and circular .....*Orphinus (Orphinus) binotatus* Pic, 1937

16(15) elytral cuticle unicolorous; antennal club 5- or 4- segmented .....*Trogoderma granarium* Everts, 1898
